

How to Become a Member

1. Worship with us and join in on our activities (see Sunday bulletins for opportunities). Learn who we are as a community in Christ.
2. Contact the pastor by checking "Desire a Call" on an attendance card found in the church pews, OR call the pastor or secretary. Phone numbers and address are on the cover of this booklet.
3. The pastor will arrange with you a time to visit with you in your own home or at the church office.
4. The pastor will help guide you toward the best path:
 - If you are already a member of an LCMS congregation, the pastor will transfer your membership to Zion.
 - If you have been baptized but are not a member of another church, the pastor will give you the instruction needed to become a confirmed and voting member.
 - If you have not been baptized, the pastor will give you the instruction needed to become a confirmed and voting member and will baptize you.
 - If you are a baptized member of a non-LCMS church, the pastor will give you the instruction needed and transfer your membership to Zion.
5. Adult Catechism Classes: will be offered by the pastor for all those who need instruction (see above).
We welcome your children! If they are of high school age or older, they may attend the Adult Catechism with you. If they are younger children, we would like them to join in with the other children's instruction (Sunday School, First Communion, Confirmation).
6. We wish to welcome and officially receive you and other new members during a Sunday worship service. The date will be coordinated with you by the pastor.
