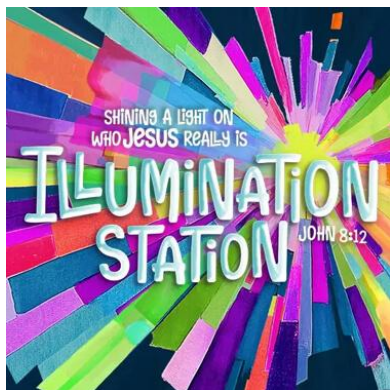

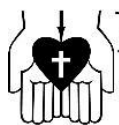


### SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

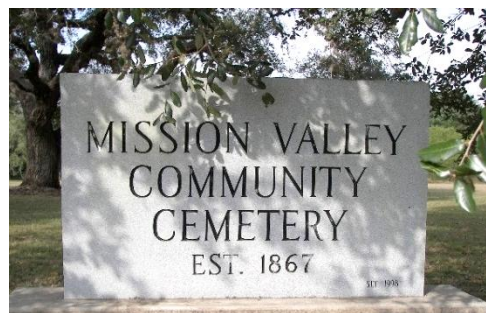
### NEW GROUP COMMUNICATION TOOL

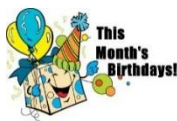

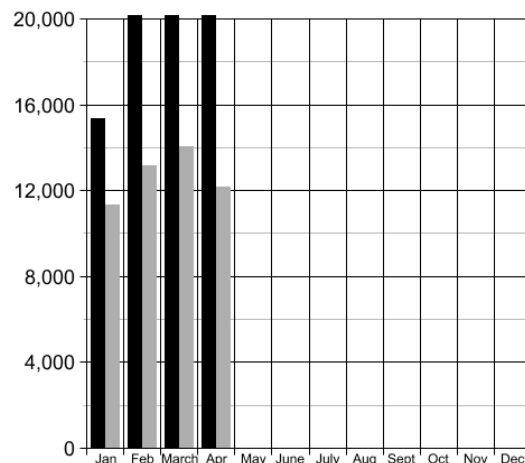
